COMMUNICATIONS

Instead of CB radios I would like to use GSMR Radios that have 3-4 times the range: **(This option is a HIGH recommendation. Bluetooth Capable) The radio is available at the [BTECH website](#), and at [Amazon](#). Use Coupon Code: RFTW** You will get both the Radio and Wireless PTT button for \$152.44. **Must Add Both items, [GMRS Pro radio](#), and [wireless PTT button](#)** to BTECH online cart. Deal Available at the [BTECH Website](#). Optional antennas are also available. I have tested these, and the range is amazing even when line of sight is not.

I have not tested this radio on my bike but have in my truck on the little antenna and was reaching out to the local CB shop nearly 7 miles away.

LEADERSHIP

- a) **Warren** is the HMFC A.K.A. Da Boss. We ask that once Departure Day arrives you refrain from asking him questions as much as possible.

GENERAL INFO

1) Ride Requirements

- a) **PLEASE fill out the medical form**, we ask you to do this not to be a pain but hopefully easy yours should the occasion arise. I recommend that you place it on a lanyard around your neck.

- b) **We do not charge a fee to ride.** However, we greatly appreciate donations to help pay for the merchandise, the gifts for the family, basic expenses and more.

3) Route Challenges

- a) The current posted MAP of the route takes us from city to city only. As each day's visits become solidified a more refined route will be published.
- b) Services – Fuel and Food stops are planned for a max of 125 miles between stops so plan accordingly. We will have extra fuel just in case. Note we try and maintain 60-65 mph. However, sometimes we must crank it up down the highway to arrive at our next visit on time.
- c) There can be stops where “Premium Unleaded is below 90 Octane plan accordingly.
- d) At this time, we do not plan on having a chase truck. Be sure your bike coverage includes towing.
